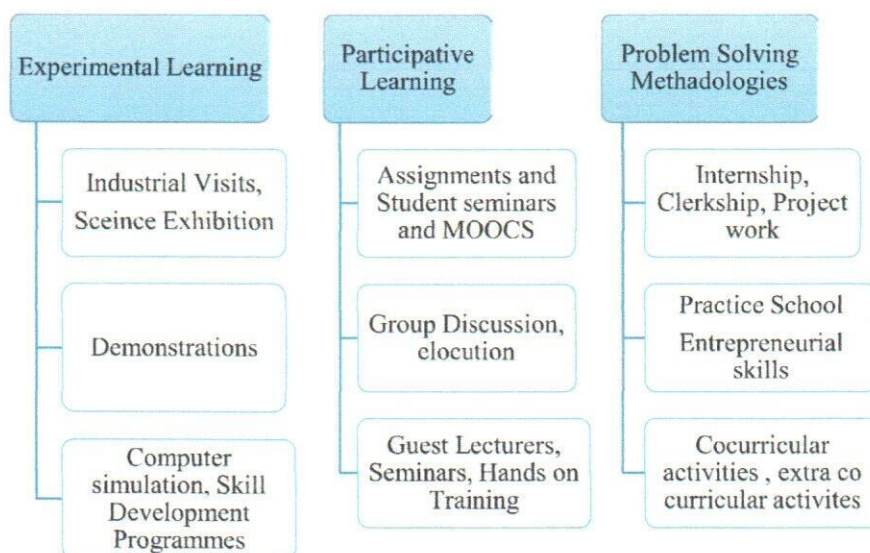
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2.3.1 - Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences

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1. Experiential learning:

The faculty members foster a learning environment by engaging in rich experiential content of teaching through experimentation, demonstration, periodical industrial visits, and skill development programs as well.

- **Industrial visits:** The institution encourages the students for industrial visits to enhance their knowledge in practical exposure.

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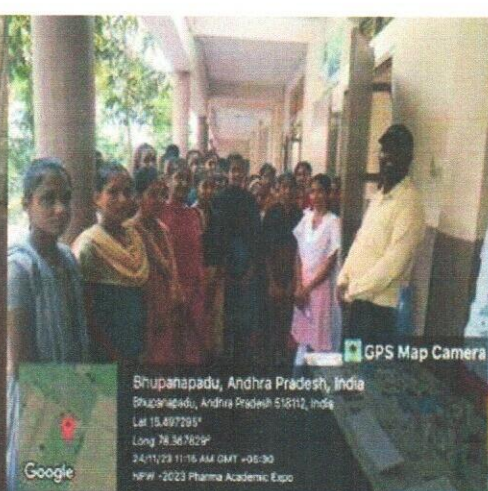
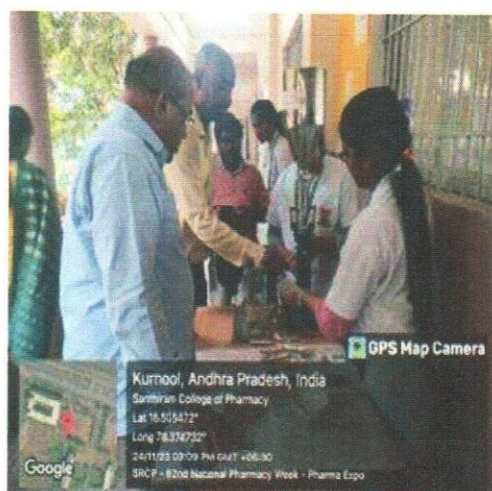
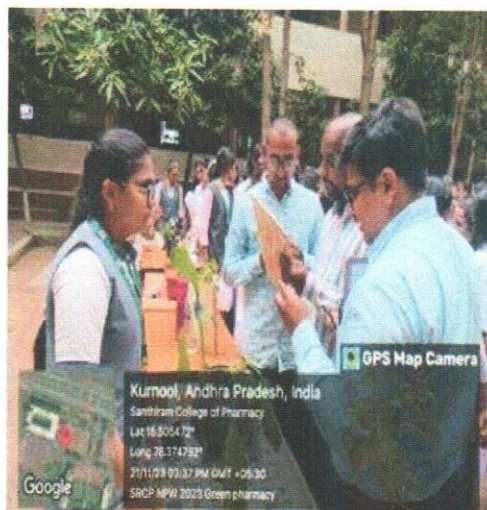
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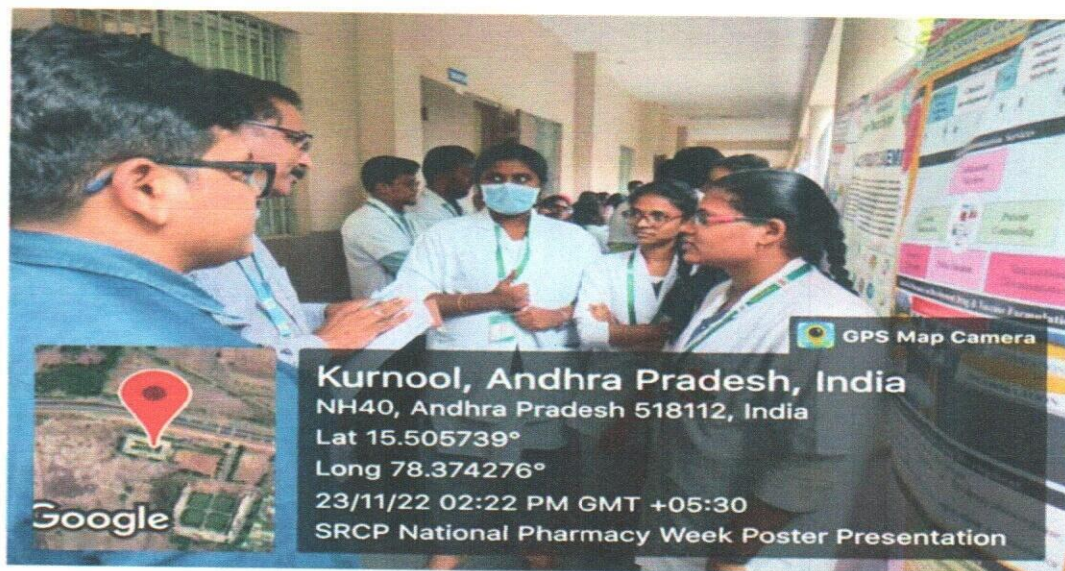
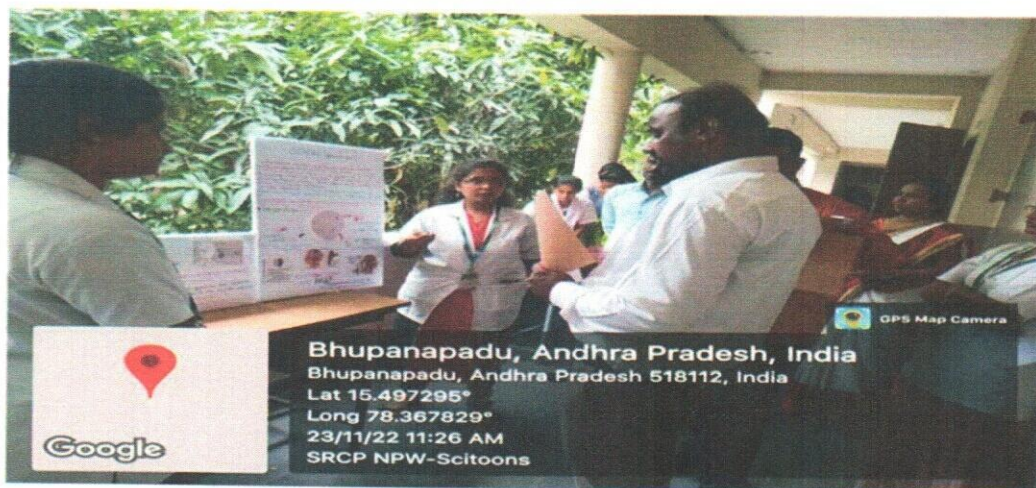


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- **Demonstrations:** Effective illustration of theoretical concepts/ demonstrations are organized to enhance the interests of students.




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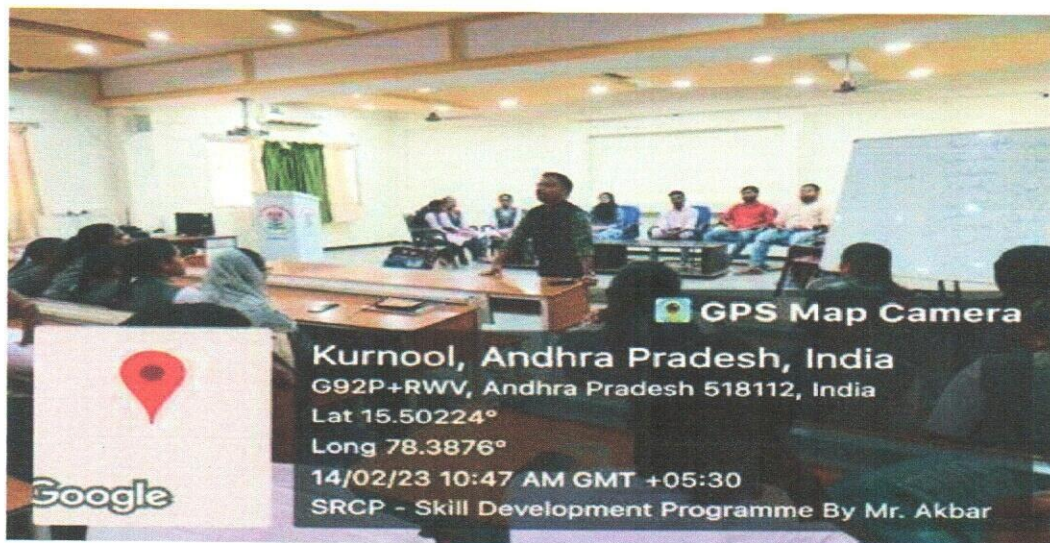


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- Skill development programmes with the enriched curriculum is designed and conducted in all courses.




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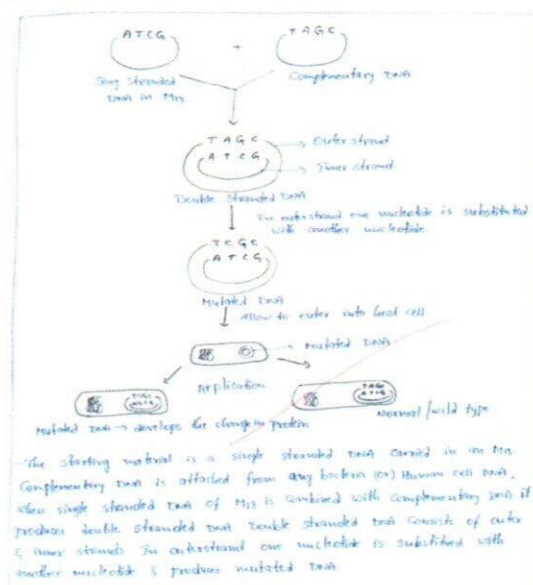
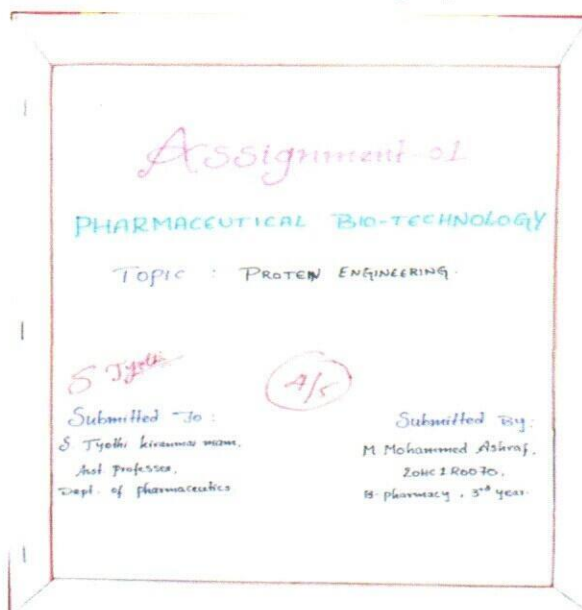

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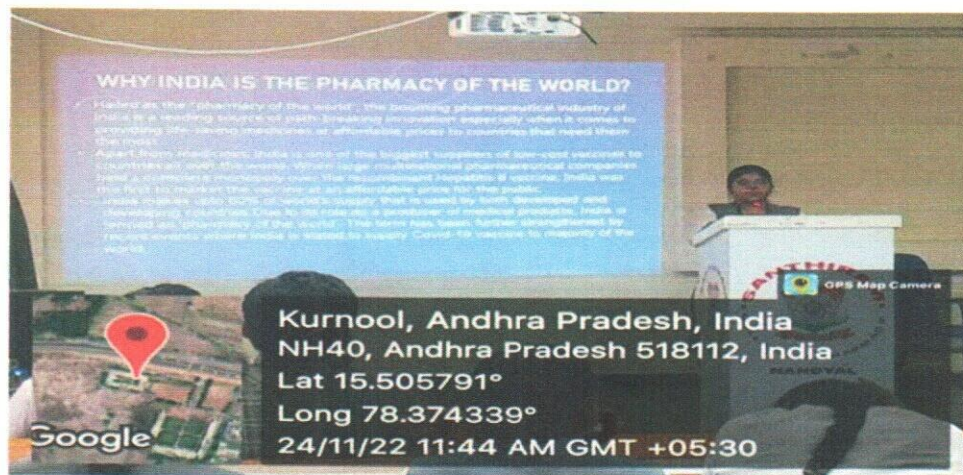

- **Clerkship/Hospital posting:** Every student of Pharm.D program shall be posted in hospital for a period of 5hrs during second, third and fourth year of the programme. In fifth year, every student shall spend half a day in the morning hours attending ward rounds on daily basis as a part of clerkship.
