It is an heritage to convey that SRCP framed a well-organized training and placement Cell in the year 2017, to enhance the skills of the students and to provide placements once after completion of the course. It has the following objectives.

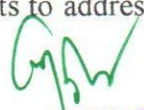
1. To impart training to the students shape their skills, and personality development.
2. To place an employment to the student while leaving the campus.
3. To provide industrial training to pre-final year students through MOU's and gain industrial exposure.
4. To provide industrial visits to our students, to have live demo on instrumentation and various machinery.
5. To provide internships to our students.

3. Context:

Institute has designed and adapted the practice of additional efforts in bringing the companies to this rural area, in an intention to provide guidance to the undergraduate students to face up the interviews and increase the recruitment number and place our students in a right job while completion of his course work. The main criteria of our institute is to provide recruitment, employment and make our students to be employees in various pharmaceutical and relevant sectors.

4. Practice:

Students joining in our institute come from very rural areas and have poor communication skills, lack of English fluency, which makes students create fear among themselves and leads to lack of confidence. Hence, there is a need to provide training for the students to address these lacunas and


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implement effective training programs to improve communication skills and make them ready to face interviews as and when required.

To achieve our requirements, we have initiated the development of skills among the students from the first year onwards to provide the basic foundation of effective learning and writing in English. Debate discussions in the English language only among the students help them gain fluency and develop communication within the class. In the second year, guest lectures from eminent faculty are arranged to enrich students' knowledge. After completing the program, students share their views and opinions in open talks for effective communication practices, apart from the regular curriculum. A one-week training program for placements will be conducted annually. Eminent trainers will be invited to the institute to conduct sessions. After the completion of the program, the trainer will conduct debate sessions, student mock tests, and interviews.

5. Evidence of Success:

Through the training program, students develop new communication skills and abilities, including writing resumes and delivering presentations. Students have joined various companies through on-campus and off-campus placements. Most of the students receive a couple of job offers while leaving the institution, depending on their interests, allowing them to select and join the company of their choice.

In addition to software-based companies' campus recruitment drives, we are making efforts to bring pharmaceutical core companies to the institution for direct recruitment of our students.

Some students initially struggled with collaboration and research. To address this, faculty provided mentorship and access to online resources. Dedicated time slots and seminar halls were essential for smooth implementation.

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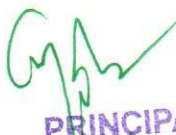

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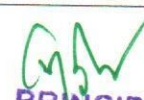
