Soap oil chemically known as sodium salt of linear alkyl benzene sulphonic acid is used as dish wash, floor cleaner and liquid detergent. Soap oil is used in household, hotels. - 2. Weigh and dissolve 2 Kg of NaOH in 40 Its of water and add 10 kgs of acid slurry slowly and Stir for 15 mins slowly.
- 3. Adjust the pH of the solution with sodium hydroxide pellets until the pH paper turns to reen. (Alkaline)
- 4. Add 49 litres of water to the solution
- 5. Leave the preparation overnight without disturbance
- 6. Then add 2kg urea, 2kg salt, 0.5 kg colour and 0.5 kg perfume.
