

Objective: The session aimed to enhance the teaching quality at Santhiram College of Pharmacy by discussing Bloom's Taxonomy and the National Educational Policy (NEP)-2020.

1.Bloom's Taxonomy Overview: Dr. L. Siva Sankar Reddy introduced Bloom's Taxonomy, a framework used to classify cognitive learning objectives.

Levels of Bloom's Taxonomy:

- **Remembering:** Recall of information.
- **Understanding:** Explaining concepts.
- **Applying:** Using information in new situations.
- **Analyzing:** Breaking information into parts.
- **Evaluating:** Making judgments.
- **Creating:** Generating new ideas.

Importance for Teaching: Bloom's Taxonomy helps teachers design effective lessons that cater to different cognitive levels and enhance student learning.

Revised Bloom's Taxonomy: The revised version (2001) uses verbs instead of nouns and focuses on cognitive skills like remembering, understanding, applying, analyzing, evaluating, and creating.

Application in Classrooms: Dr. Reddy emphasized using Bloom's Taxonomy to design assignments, exam questions, and class activities that encourage higher-order thinking.

2.NEP 2020 Overview: Dr. A.V. Badrinath explained the **National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020**, which aims to reform the Indian education system.

Key Features of NEP:

- Focus on **multidisciplinary education** and flexibility.
- **Universal access** to quality education.
- Emphasis on **skill development** and **vocational education**.

Technology Integration: NEP promotes the use of technology in education, such as digital learning tools and online platforms.


Teacher Training: Continuous professional development for teachers is a central component of NEP, ensuring they are updated with new teaching methods.
